But they didn’t understand any of this.

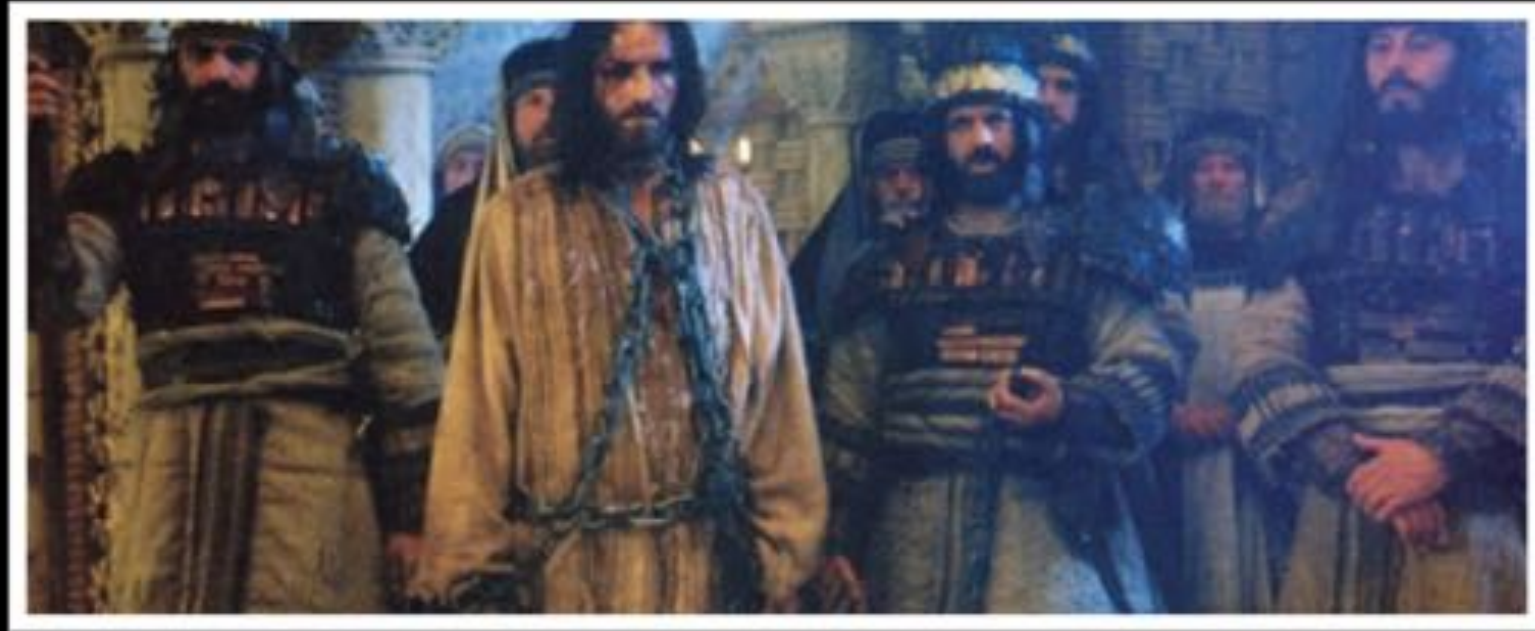
The significance of his words was
