The internship course at Cornerstone Church trains young people in all aspects of missional local church, building up disciples, seeing transformation and connecting with the local community.

The 9-month course provides training and coaching that goes beyond opportunities to volunteer, but enables interns to creatively contribute to the life of the church and community. It provides an intensive year of learning and serving to create a solid foundation for all future ministry.

- **ON-THE-JOB**

Interns at Cornerstone have the opportunity be trained ‘on-the-job.’

- **CHURCH**

This includes opportunities in all areas of church ministry and involvement in Cornerstone’s teams:

- How to preach
- Pastoral care
- Worship & Media Teams
- Ministry in the Holy Spirit. Prophecy and Healing.

Dates, Money, Accommodation:

Starts: Fri September 19th 2014

Ends: Fri July 17th 2015

The course is free to attend & unpaid.
Interns need to support themselves financially.

Option 1: Full Time

Interns volunteer 5 days a week.

Supported by sponsors, e.g. their local church, family, sponsors.

Option 2: Part Time

Interns volunteer equivalent of 3 days at Cornerstone and find a part-time job locally.

Accommodation:

Rent locally with other Interns and young people and students at Cornerstone.

Option to rent/lodge with families in Cornerstone Church – depending on availability.
